



Rib Stitch Granny Border

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Yarn

- Bernat Super Value Yarn

Hook

• 5.5 mm / I Hook or Size that Matches Your Yarn

Abbreviations

Beg = Begin(ning)
Ch(s) = Chain(s)
Dc = Double Crochet
Rep = Repeat
Sc = Single Crochet
Sk = Skip
Sl St = Slip Stitch

Sp = Space
Tr = Trebles

Pattern for Just the Regular Granny Square

Note: Ch 6 at beg of rnd counts as dc and ch 3.

Rnd 1: With A, ch 5. Join with sl st to first ch to form a ring. 1st rnd: Ch 6. (3 dc. Ch 3) 3 times in ring. 2 dc in ring. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch 6. (Four groups of 3 dc, four ch-3 sps forming corners).

Rnd 2: Sl st in next ch-3 sp. Ch 6. 3 dc in same sp as last sl st. *Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 3. 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp. Rep from * twice more. Ch 1. 2 dc in first ch-3 sp. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch 6. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: Join B with sl st in any ch-3 sp. Ch 6. 3 dc in same sp as last sl st. Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. *Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 3. 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp. Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * twice more. Ch 1. 2 dc in first ch-3 sp. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch 6.

Rnd 4: Sl st in next ch-3 sp. Ch 6. 3 dc in same sp as last sl st. 3 dc in each ch-1 sp to next corner ch-3 sp. *Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 3. 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp. Ch 1. 3 dc in each ch-1 sp to next corner ch-3 sp. Rep from *twice more. Ch 1. 2 dc in first ch-3 sp. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch 6. Fasten off.



Rep last rnd, working 2 rnds each of A, B, C, D and E, until square measures approx 36" [91.5 cm], ending with 2 rnds of any color. Fasten off.

Border Instructions

This border has raised ribs that align with each other in each round. The 2nd round will give it the ribbed look and then the 3rd round will follow the same stitches. There is a final single crochet round to finish it off. These rounds require the use of front and back posts. I have attached two extra tutorials on showing you this stitch. The ribbing give is the look of a top cuff of a pair of socks. The border is about 2" thick.



Rnd 1: Fasten onto any ch-3 space in a corner. Ch 3, 4 dc into the same ch-3 space. *1 dc in each stitch + ch-1 space across to the next corner. Each corner will have 5 dc in the ch-3 space. Repeat * around. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the beginning ch-3.

Rnds 2 - 3: Slip stitch around the back post to the centre dc in the corner. Ch 3, 4 back post double crochet in same stitch. *1 front post double crochet (fpdc) around the next post, 1 back post double crochet (bpdc) around the next. Keep repeating * to the stitch before the middle 5 dc in the corner. In the corner, 5 bpdc. Repeat * around. Join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch-3.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc into the same stitch and all stitches around. Join with a slip stitch to the beginning sc. Fasten off and weave in ends.

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
